**JUDGES: To be advised**

**Puppy** – confined to dogs less than 18 months on the day of the test.

**Novice** – confined to dogs which have not gained an award or C of M in a Field Trial, a 1st in a Novice working Test, or a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open working Test.

**Open** – no restrictions

*NB: All dogs must be KC registered.*

Entry Fees GRC\$ Members - All tests £6 per entry

Non GRC\$ Members – All tests £8 per entry

**All Entries to be made on the standard entry form which will be available on the day or can be downloaded in from the Club website**

**Please note the Small Print**

Trophies can be held for one year and to be engraved at the winning handler's expense.

**Directions to venue Sat Nav – PH1 3\$J**

**From the South – M90**

From the M90 (Edinburgh to Perth) follow the M90 until the Broxden Roundabout on the outskirts of Perth. Take the A9 north, then take the first slip road to the left, signed A85 Methven/Crieff. Just before the village of Methven, take a right turn – signposted Glenalmond/Logiealmond. Continue on this road, after a tight right bend, take the junction to the left signed for Glenalmond College. Continue past the College, until you reach a Y junction (Buchanty) take the right fork leading to the B8063.

### From the South from the A9

From the A9 – directions from just after Dunblane

From the A9 take the A85 towards Braco/Crieff at the Greenloaning junction - Pass through the villages of Braco, Muthill, and head through Crieff towards Perth. At the first village after travelling through Crieff – take a left at Gilmerton towards the Sma' Glen – A822. Continue up the glen until you reach a right branch off – take a right heading to B8063. At the next Y junction (Buchanty) take the left fork onto the B8063.

### From the North – A9

Leave the A9 at Bankfoot, head towards the village of Moneydie. At the crossroads just after Moneydie, turn right onto the B8063 signposted Logiealmond/Glenalmond.

Remain on the B8063 – pass through the village of Harrietfield. Approx 4 miles from Harrietfield, you will come to the entrance on your left to Glenalmond Estate.

Turn left into the drive of the Estate.

**Once all routes are on the B8063**, a few hundred yards after the Y junction at Buchanty Bridge, (Before the Y junction if travelling from the A9 Southbound) take the immediate left into Glenalmond Estate. Continue up the Estate Drive, past the house and the farm buildings, follow the signs, up on to the hill, continue along the hill road until you come across parking – PLEASE be respectful to the Keeper, wildlife and Estate and drive slowly through the Estate.
